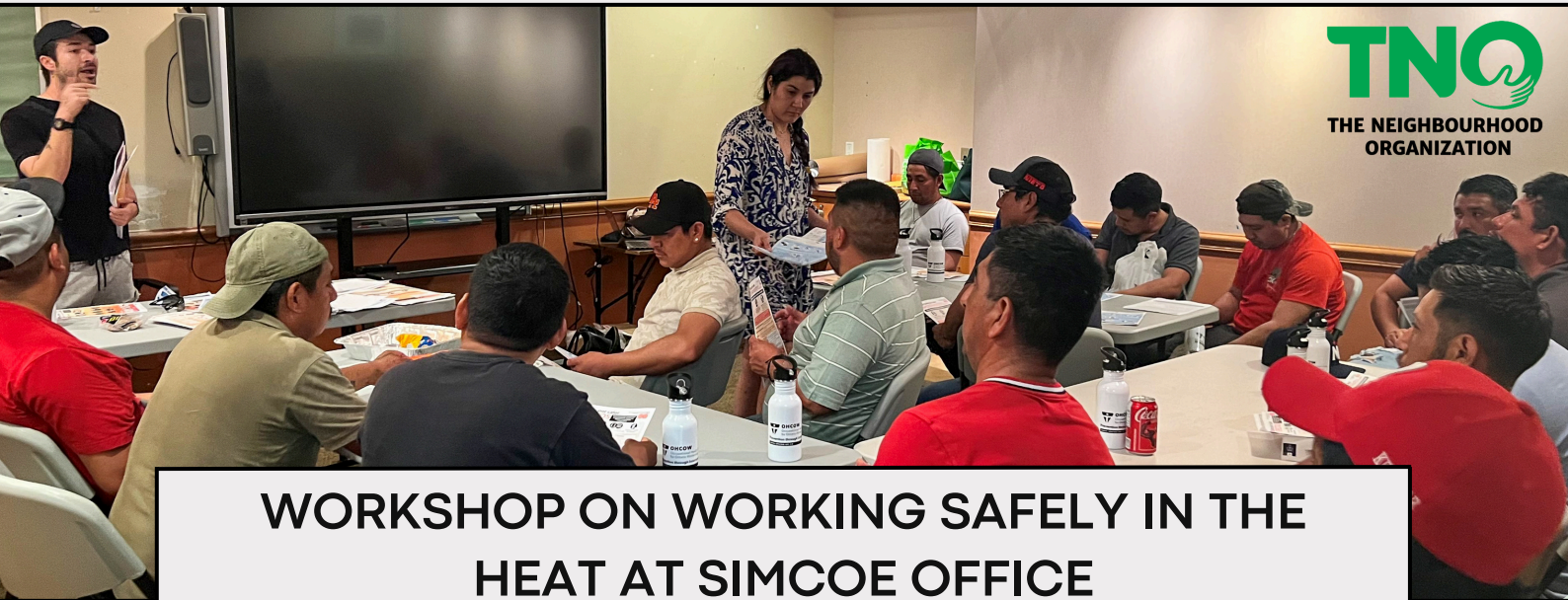
## FATHER'S DAY CELEBRATION AT BRADFORD LIBRARY
