THANKSGIVING DINNER FOR MIGRANT WORKER AT BRADFORD, ON

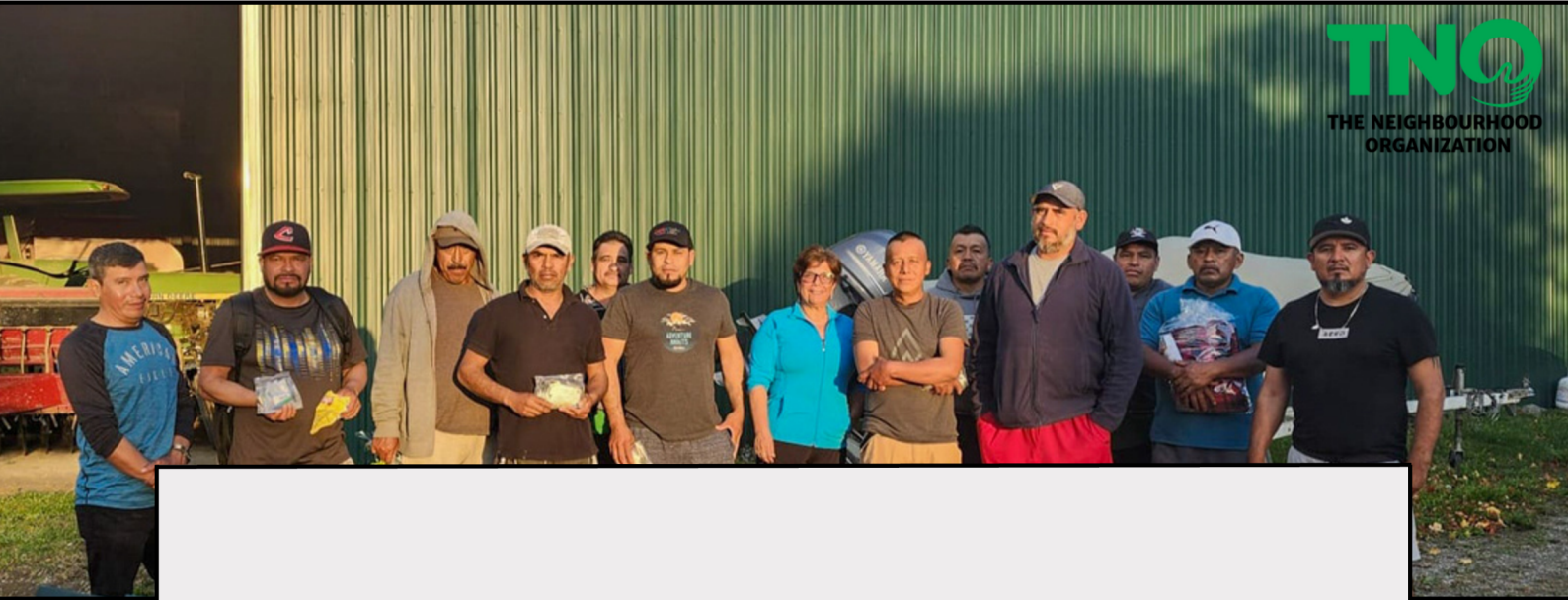
Through our Worker Support Services program, funded by the Government of Canada, We provided essential support and shared valuable information about our services to workers in Bradford, ON.
